▶ **Eiffel Tower :**

Line 6 Bir Hakeim, Line 8 Ecole Militaire,
RER C Champ de Mars

▶ **Champs Elysées :**

Line 1 - all stations between Concorde and Etoile
Line 2: Etoile, Line 6 Etoile Line 9: Franklin
D Roosevelt.
RER A - Charles de Gaulle - Etoile

▶ **The Louvre**

Lines 1 and 7 : Palais-Royal - Musée du Louvre

▶ **Paris Museum of Modern Art**

Line 9 : Alma-Marceau or Iéna

▶ **Musée d'Orsay**

RER C : Musée d'Orsay

▶ **Notre Dame Cathedral**

Line 4 Cité - RER B and RER C: Saint.
Michel Notre Dame

▶ **Sacré Coeur and Montmartre**

Line 2 : Anvers - Line 12 : Abbesses

▶ **Les Invalides**

Lines 8, Line 13 and RER C : les Invalides

▶ **Bercy Omnisports Centre**

Lines 4 or 5, Bercy

Other main destinations accessible by the RER

▶ **Disneyland Paris** (Marne la Vallée):

Take RER A from Etoile, Chatelet, Gare de
Lyon or Nation, direction Marne la Vallée (east)

▶ **Charles de Gaulle (CDG) Airport :**

Take RER B northwards from Denfert Rochereau,
Chatelet or Gare du Nord.

Take care: there are two northbound RER B
branches. Check destination boards on the
platform, and only take train going to "Aéroport
Roissy Charles de Gaulle"

▶ **La Défense business district :**

Take RER a northwest.
